








Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and began to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

How can anything so contrary to what society teaches be true?






For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways, declares the LORD. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

In the beginning God 'elohiym אלהים created the heavens and the earth.



Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent ...












Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven.

The Lord's Supper a Sacrament

Merriam-Webster Definition of SACRAMENT - a Christian rite (as baptism or the Eucharist) that is believed to have been ordained by Christ and that is held to be a means (evidence) of divine grace or to be a sign or symbol of a spiritual reality.

Origin of SACRAMENT - Middle English sacrement, sacrament, from Anglo-French & Late Latin; Anglo-French, from Late Latin sacramentum, from Latin, oath of allegiance, obligation, from sacrare to consecrate.

An Encyclopedia Britannica Company -Sacrament (noun) (Concise Encyclopedia) - Religious action or symbol in which spiritual power is believed to be transmitted through material elements or the performance of ritual. The concept is ancient; prehistoric people believed that they could advantageously influence events in the natural world, such as weather patterns, through the performance of ritual.

The word sacramentum was used in Roman law and later became an oath of allegiance soldiers swore in a sacred place.

The sacrament is primarily associated with CHRISTIANITY, and Christian theologians as early as St. AUGUSTINE focused on the proper definition of sacrament. St Augustine, in the 5th century described a sacrament as 'an outward and visible sign of an inward and invisible grace.'

Canyon Bible Church website states concerning - The Sacraments - We believe that the sacraments of baptism and the Lord's Supper are signs and seals of God's (unmerited, unsought after) grace, to represent Christ and His benefits and to put a visible difference between those who belong to the Church and the rest of the world.

The essence (bottom line) of the practice of The Lord's Supper in particular, as I see it, is an OATH of ALLEGIANCE to Jesus Christ Himself as our great Benefactor; stating that because of the purchase HE made of our souls on the cross, we willing acknowledge (IN REMBRANCE OF HIM) again and again, (AS OFT AS YE DO IT) His rightful control of our minds and bodies in the pursuance of His will here on Earth.

The fact that we not only show the Lord's death in the supper, but eat and drink the pledges of it, could only be understood by the Jews, accustomed to such feasts after propitiatory sacrifices, as implying our personal appropriation therein of the benefits of that death. JFB
