6. In the past history of the Church, to insist that baptism is for believers only and to deny the physical body of Christ is in the elements of bread and wine illustrates the mportance of these two ordinances. Their symbolism is so mportant that believers considered them worth for.
7. "This is My "(1 Cor. 11:24) does not mean Jesus' physical body is present in the bread.
B. "Do this in remembrance of Me." (1 Cor. 11:24-25) tells us that the non-literal body of Christ is a representation of His body and is meant to us of His sacrifice.
