

JESUS' TRIAL: PHASE TWO - Before Pilate

1. As believers, we are to fulfill His command to be Christ's ambassadors to the **__LOST__**.
2. *"Then they led Jesus from the house of Caiaphas to the governor's headquarters. It was early morning. They themselves did not enter the governor's headquarters so that they would not be **__DEFILED__** but could eat the Passover."* John 18:28
3. **__PILATE__** was not a skilled politician, he had no love for Judea or its people and his tendency was to deal with issues with a strong hand or violence.
4. Releasing **__JESUS__** would pay back Caiaphas for the trouble Pilate had been given by the religious leaders and the people of Jerusalem.
5. Romans were very superstitious concerning **__DREAMS__**.
6. Claudia wrote a note to Pilate saying "Have **__NOTHING__** to do with that righteous man."
7. For the remnant church, those who are not religious but live in relationship with the living God, persecution is normal and **__EXPECTED__**.
8. The world exists with two **__KINGDOMS__** - that of Christ's and that of the prince of the world.
9. "...and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and the scribes, and they will condemn him to death and deliver him over to the Gentiles. And they will mock him and **__SPIT__** on him, and flog him and kill him. And after three days he will **__RISE__**." Mark 10:33-34
10. *"For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world-to bear witness to the truth. Every-one who is of the **__TRUTH__** listens to my voice."* John 18:37
11. The question is, "What are you going to change in your life in order to comply with the **__WORD__** of God?"
