1. Written in this letter (1 John) are the basic facts you need to know and understand about JESUS.
2. Question 1 of the Westminster Catechism asks, "What is the chief end of man?" The answer is, "Man's chief end is to GLORIFY God, and to ENJOY Him forever."
3. John knows Christ because he PHYSICALLY and spiritually experienced Jesus.
4. "For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the FLESH. This is the deceiver and the antichrist."
