| 3. "As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to any different doctrine." 1 Timothy 1:3 |
| 4. The first marker of a teacher is that they teach a <i>"different doctrine"</i> . A "different doctrine" is anything that contradicts God's word as revealed in the Bible. |
| 5. Our best against false teaching is the "sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God." Ephesians 6:17 |
| 6. When examined and compared to the sound teaching of our Lord Jesus Christ, false teaching rationalizes |
| 7. Paul says a false teacher is "puffed up withand understands nothing". 1 Timothy 6:4 |
| 8. So, just as false teaching fails to teach God's truth and fails to produce holiness in people's lives, it also fails to produce |
| 9. "For the that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God." Romans 8:7-8 |
| 10. Unlike Paul who said, "I covet no one's silver or gold or apparel," false teachers seek their own Acts 20:33 |
| 11. "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to against the schemes of the devil." Ephesians 6:10-11 |
| 12. This week read Ephesians 6 and use it to inoculate vourself against the plague of false teaching. |
