

Only 7% of those in America that identify themselves as Christian tithe on a regular basis.



Among Evangelicals 24% tithe. Only 7 to 8% give at least a 10% tithe.



That means 1.7% of Evangelical Christians tithe at least 10%. The average tithe is about 1.6% of American Evangelical Christian's income for those 24% that tithe. 76% of Evangelical Christians do not tithe on a regular basis.






