8. The serpent was cursed above all species (all animals were included in God's curse), illustrating Satan's demotion from heaven and his degradation. God's curse put enmity between Eve's seed and her Seed (Christ) and the evil spirit indwelling the snake.

- How is this "Good News" and a promise for Eve?

9. When was the first ever blood sacrifice performed? By whom was it performed and on whose behalf was it performed?

10. Were Adam and Eve "saved"? Defend your answer.
