





John Wycliffe

1320s – 1384 English



John Wycliffe

Consistently argued for Scriptures as the authoritative center of Christianity, that the claims of the papacy were unhistorical and that the moral unworthiness of priests invalidated their office and sacraments.





Jan Hus

1369 – 1415 Czech



Jan Hus

During his trial Hus appealed to Jesus Christ as the supreme judge and the highest Christian authority. In doing so he bypassed the laws and structures of the Roman Catholic church and challenged the authority of the pope.



Girolamo Savonarola

1140 – 1205 Italian



Girolamo Savonarola

In 1487 he was ordered to trial by fire in order to let God judge between him and the Church. As the trial was about to begin a sudden down pour quenched the fire and the trial was cancelled. The gathered crowds became angry with the Church leaders and were disbanded violently
