BENEATH THE CROSS OF JESUS




Beneath the cross of Jesus

And the burden of the day




Upon that cross of Jesus

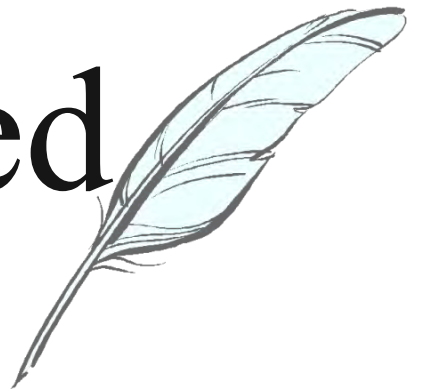

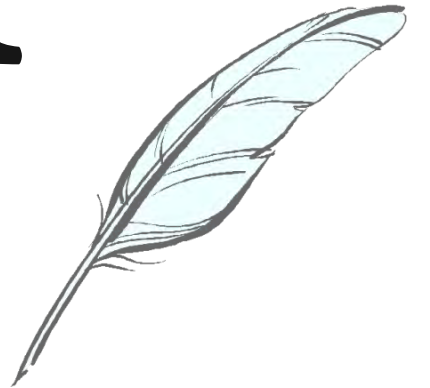
