cross**


Oh, to see the pain written on

Won through Your selfless love





Slander is a false tale or report maliciously uttered, and tending to injure the reputation of another by lessening him in the esteem of his fellow citizens, by exposing him to impeachment and punishment, or by impairing his means of living.

And He must win the battle


That word above all earthly
